

Lake Lesjön and river Rörströmsälven

Lesjön fishing area

Your contact person at Lesjön Camp, Steiner, will provide You with excellent fishing in a large and productive water system.

Here you will find top class cabins, nicely situated in the forest, overlooking the lake Lesjön. The lake is only 50 m away from Your house. If You like silence, north Swedish landscape and fishing, then this is the place for You.

At summertime You can sit and enjoy the nice summer evening, while You are looking at the exploding water, when a pike or a brown trout, attacks its prey.

The only thing that disturbs the silence is the sound from the surrounding forest.

Only 5 minutes car drive from the camp, You will find the beautiful river Rörströmsälven, and it's wild stocks of brown trout and grayling.

In the slow parts of this river, filled with weeds and different kinds of hiding areas, You will find big species of both pike and perch.

Fish species

Pike and perch are the most common species. Every year a good number of big, brown trout (1-4 kg) are caught in lake Lesjön. The river Rörströmsälven keeps trout, grayling, perch and pike.

Fishing areas

The fishing area is situated along the lake Lesjön and the river Rörströmsälven. The rivers outflow to lake Lesjön is close to the camp. This is a hot spot, as it's a very productive area, well known for keeping big pike, perch and trout. About 15 km from the camp You will find the village Rossön and the lake Bodumsjön. You can also find several small forest lakes with trout and char . The river Vängelälven (35 km away) is also a very nice river with grayling and brown trout.

Fishing season

Fishing for pike is best during the month of June especially the weeks around midsummer. Even autumn can produce some large pike. Perch bite best during the period of July – September. Trout fishing reaches its peak in June, particularly around midsummer when the lake flies hatch.

Accommodation

The fishing camp has two cabins for rental. The standard is high as they were finished as late as 2012. On the camp You will only see those houses, the forest and the lake Lesjön. So You will be in direct contact with the Swedish nature, but still close to a village with groceries, gasoline and a tackle shop.

Röda stugan (red cabin) is situated 50 m from the lake Lesjön It has six single beds, kitchen, WC, shower, sauna and TV.

Grå stugan (grey cabin) is 50m from the lake Lesjön and app. 50 m away from the "Röda stugan". It has 4 single beds, kitchen, WC, shower, sauna and TV.

Boats at the camp are Linder 430/440 aluminium boats with Suzuki 4-stroke 5 HP motors.

The cabin "Röda stugan" is only 50 m from Lake Lesjön with 6 beds, shower, sauna, TV and a small kitschen.

Fishing regulations

In rivers the fishing is prohibited between September-May. We strongly recommend catch and release for pike over 75 cm, and 40 cm minimum size for trout and grayling (max one grayling/trout may be kept per day). Sport fishing tackle can be bought in the local fishing shop.

Other activities

Interesting sights to see are the rock paintings at Harahällarna located at the mouth of the river Nagasjöåns, the nature reserve at Vallsjön with centuries-old pines, hiking trails in the Bollbergs Nature Reserve and the Homestead museum with a Stone Age museum. There is also a nine hole golf course.
